The Official Notice Board will be the Virtual Notice Board (VNB), published on Sportity. There will be <u>NO</u> physical official notice board. All competitors will be informed via the Sportity app about the publication of any documents on the Virtual Notice board (VNB)

The Sportity app will be the primary route for the issue/notification of rally documents (e.g., start and restart lists, bulletins and on-event information). As a result, it is important that the crew have access to the app and any support members of the team are also encouraged to arrange access.

Article 1. Announcement

The National section will be a qualifying round of the Fuchs Lubricants British Historic Championship, and the Interclub section will form a round of the J D Tyres Welsh Tarmacadam Championship, the Marsh Insurance King of Epynt Challenge, the ANWCC Stage Rally Championship and the Mini Sport Cup.

Article 2. Jurisdiction

<u>Category I</u>

Cars of a specification valid on or before Ist January 1968 complying with section R49 of the 2023 Motorsport UK Competitor Yearbook

<u>Category 2</u>

Cars of a specification valid between the 1st January 1968 and the 31st December 1974 complying with section R49 of the 2023 Motorsport UK Competitor Yearbook

Category 3

Cars homologated in Groups I, 2, 3 or 4 between I January 1975 and 31 December 1981. Cars in Category 3 must comply with their Homologation and complying with section R49 of the 2023 Motorsport UK Competitor Yearbook.

Category 4a

Cars homologated in Groups A, N and B between I January 1982 and 31 December 1985 excluding any cars that were regulated out by the FIA in period from rallies for safety reasons. Cars in Category 4 must comply with their Homologation forms and Appendix J of the 1985 FIA Yellow Book.

Cars homologated in Group B with an effective engine capacity exceeding I6OOcc must have been issued with a valid FIA Historic Technical Passport (HTP), be in compliance with this document and the current FIA Appendix K at all times.

Category 4b

Cars homologated in Groups A, N and B between I January 1986 and 31 December 1990 excluding any cars that were regulated out by the FIA in period from rallies for safety reasons.

Cars in Category 4b must comply with their Homologation forms and Appendix J of the 1990 FIA Yellow Book and must have been issued with a valid FIA Historic Technical Passport (HTP), be in compliance with this document and the current FIA Appendix K at all times.

Category K - FIA Appendix K Class

Historic Rally Cars fully compliant with the current FIA Appendix K to the International Sporting Code. Cars must have been issued with a valid FIA. Historic Technical Passport (HTP), be in compliance with this document and the current FIA Appendix K at all times. Vehicles are exempt from 46.1.3.

Non-Historic Cars – Rally 2

2 wheeled drive cars complying with Motorsport UK Regulations pre-31 December 1990 but do not comply with Historic Rally Regulations.

- 8.1 Should the number of entries, overall or in each class, not reach the minimum stated, the Organisers have the right to either cancel the Event or to amalgamate classes where necessary (Article 6.2).
- 8.2 Final Instructions and any other information will be available on Sportity before the event, containing all the information required.
- 8.3 Entrants are required to indicate on the Entry Form their eligibility for the various Championships.
- 8.4 The order of starting will be at the organisers discretion but, to assist seeding, entrants should provide their previous results on the Entry Form.
- 8.5 **Competitors are advised that the information they provide will be stored in a computer system and may be used for organisational and publicity purposes.**
- 8.6 The Entry Fee is £450.00. The maximum entries for the event are IOO plus reserves, the minimum will be 65. The first 80 entries will be accepted on receipt of a submitted FULL entry form and FULL payment, the rest of the entries will be at the organiser`s discretion.
- 8.7 Entries will NOT be fully accepted until paid in FULL
- 8.8 Entries can ONLY be made via the on-line entry form and payment can ONLY be made by BACS.
- 8.9 Refunds for withdrawn entries will be:
 Up to 9.00am on Monday 24th July 2023 less £20.00 administration fee.
 After 9.00am on Monday 24th July 2023 and up to Friday 29th July less £50.00

Interim and Final results will be available throughout the day in the service area, on Sportity and the results service web site 'AMC results`

10.1 Protests must be made in accordance with (C5 & H34)

Article 11. Route / Roadbook / Documentation

- 11.1 The event will contain special stages on private property, joined by Public Highway. Special Stages will be timed to an accuracy of less than one minute by Marshal`s under the supervision of a Motorsport UK appointed timekeeper. 2 Cars per minute will leave MCI, with Motorsport UK approval, stages will start at thirty-second intervals. (R3I.2.9).
- 11.2 Full details of the Route and Special Stages will be given in the Road Book which will be available to competitors electronically no later than Monday 24th July. This documentation will contain all the information necessary to enable competitors to comply with (R33).
- 11.3 Original hard copy road books will be available at recce signing on or event signing on.
- 11.4 The route will be contained on Ordnance Survey I:50,000, map number I60.
- 11.5 Rally Headquarters will be at the Quarry on Epynt.
- 11.6 Total mileage will be approx. 140 miles, of which approx. 60 miles will be special stages.

Article 12. Scrutineering & Signing On

- I2.I All vehicles must comply with 2023 Motorsport UK Technical Regulations.
- I2.2 Scrutineering will be hands on for all vehicles at a location to be advised

Article 13. Damage Declaration

I3.I Competitors will be required to complete and sign declaring they have/have not done any third-party damage and hand in at final MC, or send to the secretary of the event within 72 hours,

Failing to make declaration that competitor will be reported to Motorsport UK

Article 14. Driving Standards / Observers / Judges of Fact

- 14.1 Named Judges of Fact, appointed by the Organisers, will be on duty throughout the rally to observe and report upon any competitor considered to be in contravention of (R24.7-R24.10.1).
- 14.2 The Chief Scrutineer is a Judge of Fact in respect of Vehicle Eligibility.
- 14.3 The Start Officials on all Special Stages will be empowered to judge whether or not a competitor has made a false start.

Article 15. Controls & Timing

- 15.1 Timing of the event will be governed by the Target Timing Regulations (R 3I.I R32-I.3) using digital clocks operated by Officials under the control of a MOTORSPORT UK appointed Timekeeper.
- 15.2 Maximum permitted lateness between MTC`s will be IS minutes
- 15.3 It is the competitor`s responsibility to ensure that the times are correctly recorded. Should any recorded time not be legible or not appear authentic the Organisers may use any means at their disposal to establish a time.

Article 16. Route Notes

- 16.1 Route notes are allowed (R25.9 R25.9.5 does not apply).
- 16.2 Local by-laws excluding private vehicles on military roads are still operative; therefore, any competitor found on the Epynt roads prior to the event will not be allowed to start and reported to Motorsport UK and the WAMC.
- 16.3 AC Maps will be providing a digital DVD FOC. If a competitor requires a physical DVD, the cost will be as advert below, AC maps can also supply Route notes, these can be arranged by contacting AC Maps 07802 400 402.

Descriptive	bend severity represented by a description

Each system is available with the bend severity or direction first.



Article I7. Servicing

- 17.1 All servicing work carried out and the carrying of fuel in the Service Vehicle should comply with any appropriate Health & Safety Executive recommendations.
- 17.2 Competing crews may work unassisted on their own cars in "Non Service Areas" except: -
 - (a) Within IOO meters of any control.
 - (b) Between the SSA/TC control and the SSS control.
 - (c) In any "Park Ferme". the only work permitted in these areas is to carry out thefollowing, unassisted: - (i) Clean lamp glasses, windscreens and windows.
- 17.3 Service crews are subject to the same regulations as competitor`s regarding noise, bad driving manners, etc. Officials and Marshals have been instructed to note any infringements of the rules (Article 14.5).

Article I8. Penalties

- 18.1 Classification for the results will be determined by total time penalties, the winner being the competitor with the least total penalty.
- 18.2 In the event of a tie the winner will be the competitor who has completed the greatest distance from the start with the least Stage Penalties.
- 18.3 The penalties in R32.2 will apply unless modified in these SR`s
- 18.4 Contravention of the following R25.3 R25.3.2, may lead to a REFUSED START: -

Competitors are reminded of (R24.5 – R24.5.2) for details of computation of penalties in the event that the normal running of a stage is stopped. Should it be necessary to cancel a special stage during the Rally, or to delete one from the results after the event, only the Stage Penalty will be deleted. Unless an Official notice has been issued to the contrary, the cancelled stage must be traversed within Target Time and will be treated as a road section.

- 18.5 Causing an obstruction on an access road to or from a Special Stage will be penalised by DISQUALIFICATION from the results (Article 18.4), (R32.2 (g)) will apply.
- 18.6 Not complying with a requirement of these regulations for which no other penalty is specified:
 30 minutes.
- 18.7 Failure to negotiate a chicane correctly i.e., hitting it, will result in a penalty, which will be a Two strikes and out. Ist offence IO seconds 2nd offence 2 minutes/

3rd offence disqualification

- 18.8 Competitors are reminded of (R25.6.7 R 25.6.3), (R32.2) will apply.
- 18.9 Not completing correctly or missing a stage 5 Minutes plus stage maximum per stage

Article 20. Fuel

Cars competing in British and Motorsport UK Titled Championships, and all new build cars for, Rallycross, Car Racing, Special Stage Rallying, Sprints and Hill Climbs must be equipped with the facility to enable a fuel sample to be taken. For fuel injected cars the facility must be a dry break fuel sampling coupling, approved by the FIA, Competitors to make available a 300mm minimum length of hose to which, where necessary, the appropriate mating part is to be attached.

Article 21. Insurance

<u>Insurance</u>

Vehicles must have a valid motor insurance policy which provides as a minimum, Third Party Liability cover that complies with the Road Traffic Act. This can either be covered by extending an existing motor policy to cover the event, or, by purchasing additional cover provided under the Event Road Section Scheme, as an adjunct to an existing motor policy. If a competitor has an extension to their existing policy, they will be required to sign a declaration that the motor insurance complies with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act. Any responsibility for a fraudulent or misleading declaration about existing cover lies with the competitor.

If a competitor wishes to purchase additional Road Section cover via the event organisers then they can do so prior to the event providing the driver complies with the following:

- is aged 19 years or over
- has held a full driving licence for a minimum of 6 months
- has no more than 6 points on their licence
- has had no more than I fault claim in the last 3 years
- does not have the Third-Party Extension cover on their existing motor policy
- the vehicle has a valid MOT and taxed for the road, unless exempt from doing so

Any driver aged less than 19 years old will also be accepted at the same price should their codriver be a more senior member of their family or over 25. Any competitor who falls outside these parameters may be offered cover at equivalent terms or an agreed price, but only if approval from Shepherd Compello Motorsport has been obtained by the event organisers, prior to the event. Approval can be sought by sending an email to motorsport@shepherdcompello.com and provide the Drivers` name and date of birth, the date they past their driving test and details of any motoring claims and/or convictions. Additional cover provided by this scheme is only effective whilst the vehicle is actively competing in the event and remains under the control or direction of the event organiser(s). Cover will cease immediately if you are precluded, excluded or retire from the event. The Event Organiser`s RTA scheme is provided by Shepherd Compello Motorsport Insurance and underwritten by First Underwriting Limited.
